### **BABRT Recognized as Green Super Hero at PG&E's Green Heroes Awards Event**

Oakland – California. On the evening of November 18<sup>th</sup>, the Bay Area Business RoundTable (BABRT) was among various Oakland-based organizations that gathered at the Paramount Theater. They came together in honor of PG&E's Green Heroes Awards, an event recognizing the efforts of those who took part in the Greening of Oakland Campaign. This green campaign was implemented in partnership with the City of Oakland and a number of local organizations. Since 2007, the campaign has implemented numerous projects, including the launch of a green jobs training program with the Regional Technical Training Center (RTTC), BABRT's affiliated workforce development agency.

The BABRT was not only recognized as a Green Hero for RTTC's launch of the Field Technician Installer Green Jobs Training Program but they also received a Green Super Hero Award for starting the first-ever Public Policy Leadership Boot Camp in conjunction with author, attorney and activist, Christine Pelosi and U.C. Berkeley Extension.

PG&E provided scholarships for four students to attend the class, which concluded on November 24<sup>th</sup>. Due to positive feedback, U.C. Berkeley has decided to offer the Public Leadership Boot Camp again during spring, which will start in March of 2010.

The BABRT is a 501(c)(3) focused on fostering positive change and economic development in the San Francisco Bay Area.
